

The Best MCP Servers for Cold Email in 2026

17 MCP servers from cold email and outreach vendors, ranked by what an AI agent can do with them, what stops it from sending or spending without you, hosting and documentation. Scores from the published rules, facts from each vendor's own pages.

THE SHORT VERSION

Outreach2day is the best MCP server for cold email in 2026 (10.0 of 10 by the published rules), ahead of Mailjinn (8.8) and SalesBlink (8.8): it covers domains, mailboxes, warm-up, campaigns and replies, and an agent can quote an order but only a person can pay for it.

Disclosure. Published by Outreach2day, which ranks itself #1. Outreach2day makes one of the servers in this ranking and competes with several other vendors in the table. All are scored by the same four published rules; the scope of our server and the age of its OAuth sign-in are on its card.

Key findings

Outreach2day ranks first at 10.0. Mailjinn and SalesBlink follow at 8.8. Rank follows the unrounded score: Mailjinn and SalesBlink both round to 8.8 (8.80 and 8.75). Equal unrounded scores are ordered by coverage, then by name: Emailchaser and Icemail both score 7.40 with full coverage, and PlusVibe (coverage 9) ranks above FoxReach (coverage 6) at 5.90.

6 servers can spend money through their tools (Outreach2day, Instantly, Salesforce (Forge), Emailchaser, Zapmail and Icemail). Of all 17, 3 enforce a confirmation on the server before a send or a purchase (Outreach2day, Mailjinn and Zapmail); 4 document none (PlusVibe, FoxReach, Maildoso and Smartlead).

Our own server went live on September 29, 2026, with OAuth sign-in the same day. It is scored by the same rules as the other 16.

THE VERDICT IN ONE SENTENCE

Outreach2day is the best MCP server for cold email in 2026 (10.0 of 10 by the published rules), ahead of Mailjinn (8.8) and SalesBlink (8.8): it covers domains, mailboxes, warm-up, campaigns and replies, and an agent can quote an order but only a person can pay for it.

Frequently asked questions

What is an MCP server for cold email?

A Model Context Protocol server that exposes a cold email product's actions (campaigns, leads, replies, mailboxes, warm-up, domains) as tools an AI assistant such as Claude, ChatGPT or Cursor can call.

Can an AI agent spend money through these servers?

Through Outreach2day, Instantly, Salesforce (Forge), Emailchaser, Zapmail and Icemail, yes. Give the agent a key with the smallest scope the vendor offers and keep a spending limit in the vendor's billing settings.

Why does confirmation weigh 25%?

Because an agent that sends to a list or buys domains by mistake costs money and reputation. The rules reward servers that stop and ask; a team that wants an agent to run without stopping can weigh coverage alone.

Does a missing feature score zero?

A feature the vendor does not document scores as missing, even if it exists. A vendor that documents it gets the score at the next re-check.

Which clients can use the Outreach2day server?

Claude Code, Claude Desktop, Cursor, VS Code, Windsurf, Gemini CLI and Codex with an API key in a header, and clients that connect only through OAuth, such as claude.ai and the ChatGPT app.

Is Apollo in the ranking?

No. Apollo and La Growth Machine run MCP servers for prospecting and multichannel campaigns rather than cold email infrastructure, so they are left out.

How this report was put together

Published by Outreach2day, which ranks itself #1. Outreach2day makes one of the servers in this ranking and competes with several other vendors in the table. All are scored by the same four published rules; the scope of our server and the age of its OAuth sign-in are on its card.

Scoring

We score the MCP server itself. Four criteria, each 0 to 10, from the vendor's own pages; the total is the weighted average.

Hosting and auth	20%	10 hosted with OAuth; 7 hosted with an API key in a header; 4 API key in the URL; 3 local only
Documentation	15%	10 a public tool list (docs, README, source, or a list the server returns without sign-in); 5 setup docs without a full tool list; 2 a blog post only

Sources

Every fact comes from the vendor's documentation, GitHub repository or the tool list its server returns, as linked on the web version of this ranking (last updated undefined undefined, NaN).

What this report is not

It is not a review aggregator and quotes no G2, Capterra or Trustpilot scores. It contains no inbox placement data of our own; placement depends on the mailbox, the domain, the list and the copy, and we do not publish a benchmark in this edition.

Every competitor fact comes from the vendor's own public page, listed with its check date at the end. Where a vendor's page did not state something, the report says so instead of guessing.

Corrections
